### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to establish that medical residents working in a hospital under the direction of a supervising physician are not required to enroll with Puerto Rico Medicaid Program (PRMP).

### Scope

All references to the PRMP in this policy are inclusive of Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). This policy covers all intern or resident providers (including out-of-state providers) who are under the supervision of an enrolled physician in the PRMP.

## **Policy**

Unlicensed medical interns and residents are not permitted to enroll with the PRMP. A hospital must use the supervising physician's National Provider Identifier (NPI) when billing for services rendered by an unlicensed medical intern or resident. Supervising physicians must be a Medicaid enrolled provider.
