Scope

All references to the PRMP in this policy are inclusive of Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). This policy covers all providers enrolling in the PRMP, including out-of-state providers, as well as ordering, prescribing, and referring (OPR) providers.

Policy

PRMP will rely on the federal fingerprint-based background check and site visit from Medicare's screening when a provider is enrolled with Medicare and has been screened within the past 5 years (regardless of whether the provider is located in state or out of state). PRMP will rely on the federal fingerprint-based background check and site visit from another State Medicaid's screening for an out-of-state provider when the provider has been screened within the past 5 years. Screenings from Medicare and other State Medicaid programs must be verified through PECOS for Medicare and with

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the other State Agency for Medicaid. The Provider Enrollment Portal (PEP) has an automated screening with Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA), Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Medicaid and Medicare Terminations, Provider Enrollment, Chain, and Ownership System (PECOS), National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES), Office of Inspector General/List of Excluded Individuals/Entities (OIG/LEIE), Social Security Administration (SSA) Death Master File, State Licenses and System of Award Management (SAM). PRMP reserves the right to require new fingerprints and or site visits on a case-by-case basis.
