Purpose:

Define the Prosthetic and Orthotic Supplies (POS) and Implant Suppliers' requirements enrolling in the Puerto Rico Medicaid Program (PRMP).

Scope

All references to the PRMP in this policy are inclusive of Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). This policy applies to the POS and Implant Suppliers enrolling in PRMP.

Policy

In order to be and maintain enrolled in PRMP, all the POS and Implant Suppliers must comply with the following requirements:

- Must provide complete and accurate information on the application. Any changes to this
 information must be reported to the Provider Enrollment and Maintenance Unit (PEMU) team
 by email within 30 days of the change.
- Must have comprehensive liability insurance in the amount of at least \$300,000 that covers both, the supplier's place of business, all customers, and employees of the supplier. If the supplier manufacturers perform its own products, this insurance must also cover product liability and complete operations.
- Must disclose any person having ownership, financial or control interest, convicted of any criminal offense relating to the Medicare or Medicaid program. Civil or monetary penalties imposed relating to health care programs and has been excluded from participating in Medicare or any state health care program.
- POS and Implant Suppliers newly enrolling in PRMP are designated by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) as "high" categorical risk.

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- Need to comply with "high' categorical risk screening requirements such as a fingerprint, criminal history disclosures, sites visit.
- POS and Implant Suppliers revalidating in PRMP are designated by CMS as "moderate" categorical risk.
- Comply with state and federal licensure regulatory requirements.
- Maintain signage and hours posted, maintain accessibility during reasonable business hours.
- Is required to maintain record storage for ordering and referring documentation.
- Must disclose upon enrollment all products and services, including additions of new products lines.
- Pharmacies that also supply POS must submit two applications. One application as a pharmacy and one as a POS.
